



Fall 2024: 5% (12) Fall 2023: 7% (24) Fall 2022: 6% (18) Fall 2021: 5% (12)




5-year enrollment averages Fall 2019 – Spring 2024:

Marital/Dep Status Fall 2024:

10% of students are married with dependents; 44% are single with dependents 82% of students with dependents are single

76% of the students who are single with dependents are female



Student Aid by Type

PELL Eligibility Fall 2024:

Out of 329 students 178 (74%) completed the Federal Application for Student Aid (FAFSA)

141 of the 178 applicants (79%) received PELL

59% of the total student population received PELL Fall 2024




