Qualifying degree programs include environmental science, natural resource management, environmental education, forestry, wildlife, fisheries, outdoor recreation planning, range management and other related sciences such as ecology, biology (conservation, field, marine), zoology, geology, and hydrology. **Applications must be received by March 31st, 2025**. Selections will be made May 2025. Funds will be distributed directly to the student upon successful completion of fall semester. Funds may be used for tuition, fees, books, room and board, or other research expenses related to the applicant's major.
