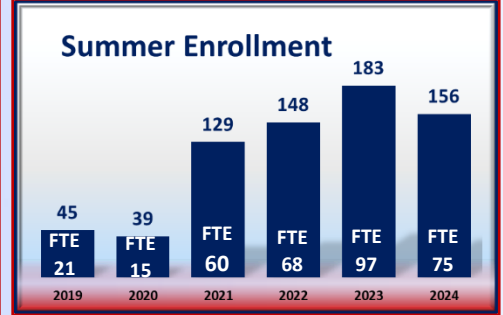
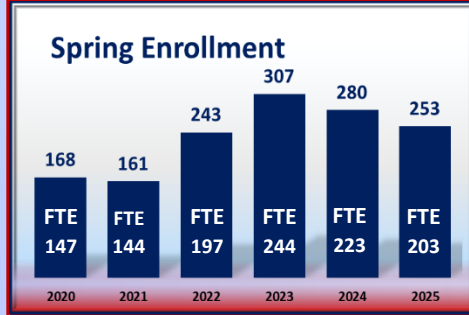
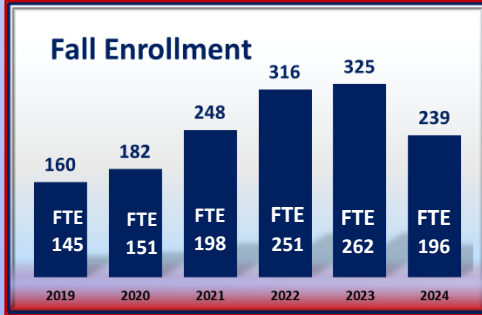




## Enrollment Trends

Fall 2020 – Spring 2025:

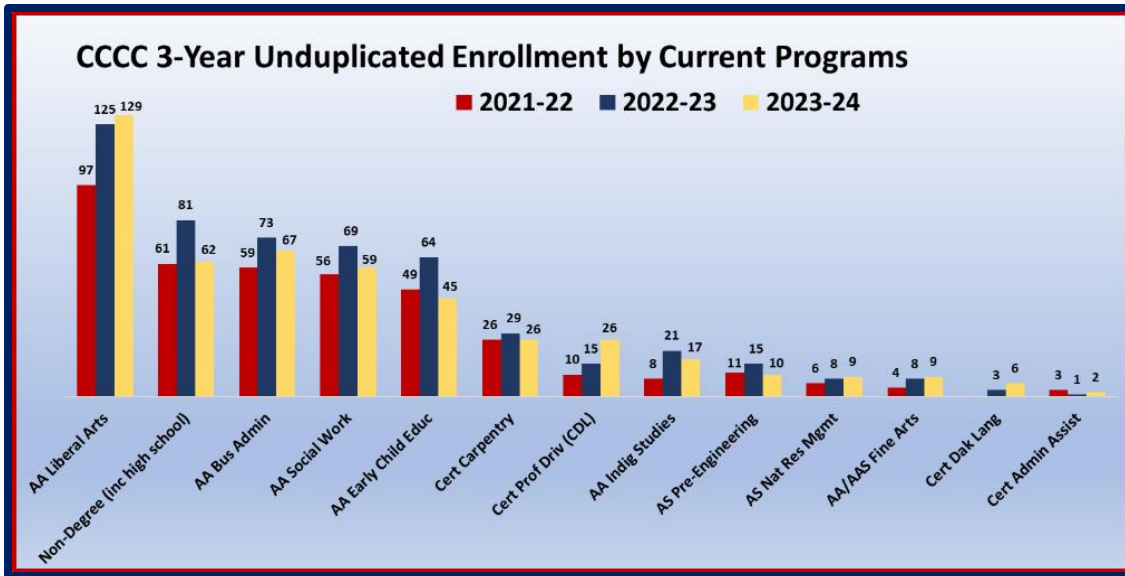
- 45% Full-Time, 55% Part-Time

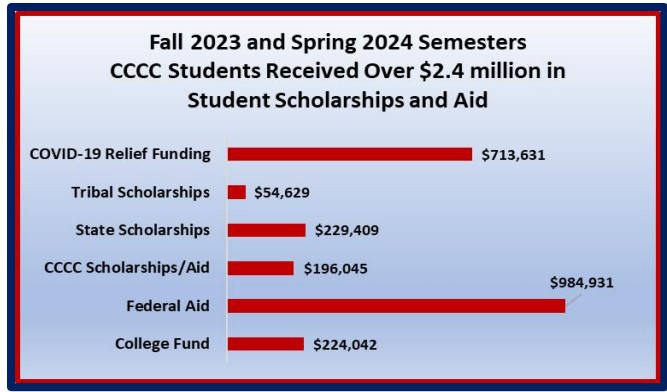
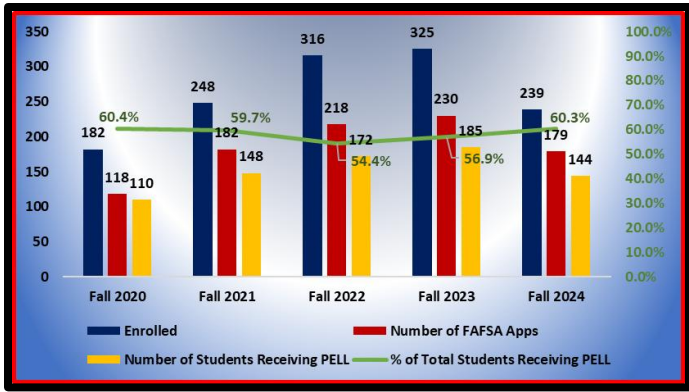

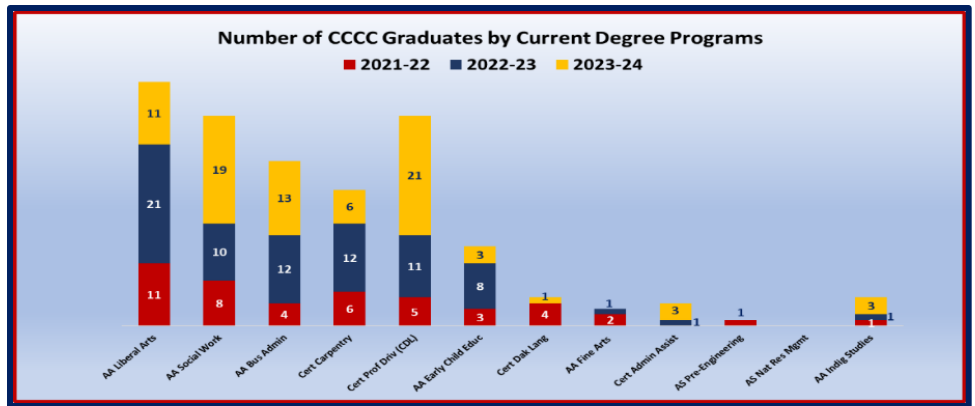
### Fall SAP: Students making Satisfactory Academic Progress continues to increase

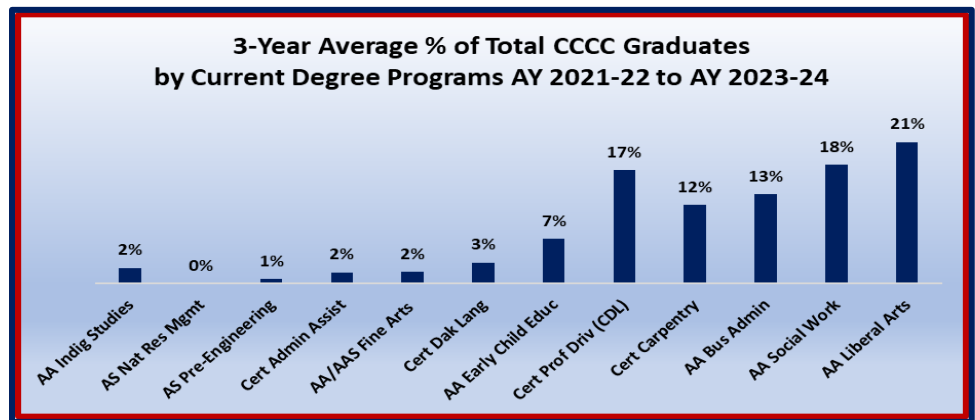
